- Merit
- Scholastic record
- Demonstrated leadership ability
- Evidence of community service and participation in extracurricular activities
- Additional consideration will be given to relatives of Twentieth Century Club members

Scholarship(s) of \$500 will be given. The award will be presented to the recipient at his/her awards ceremony, if scheduled. A check for the full scholarship amount will be sent directly to the student upon the receipt of documentation of registration for the first semester of college, university, or trade school during the 2025-2026 school year.

4. Three {3} letters of recommendation.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
