Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- Accuracy and thoroughness in completing the Scholarship Application
- Academic record with at least an overall GPA of 2.0 (calculated on a 4-point scale)
- Class ranking
- Academic & Career Plans Essay
- Faculty recommendations (2)
- Interview with Eastman Representatives
- Citizenship of the United States, DACA, or lawful residency with the intention of becoming a US citizen at the earliest opportunity allowed by law
- Final review by Eastman Scholarship Selection Team

Deadline to apply is January 31st. Applying to all scholarships is encouraged but applicants can only accept one scholarship.
